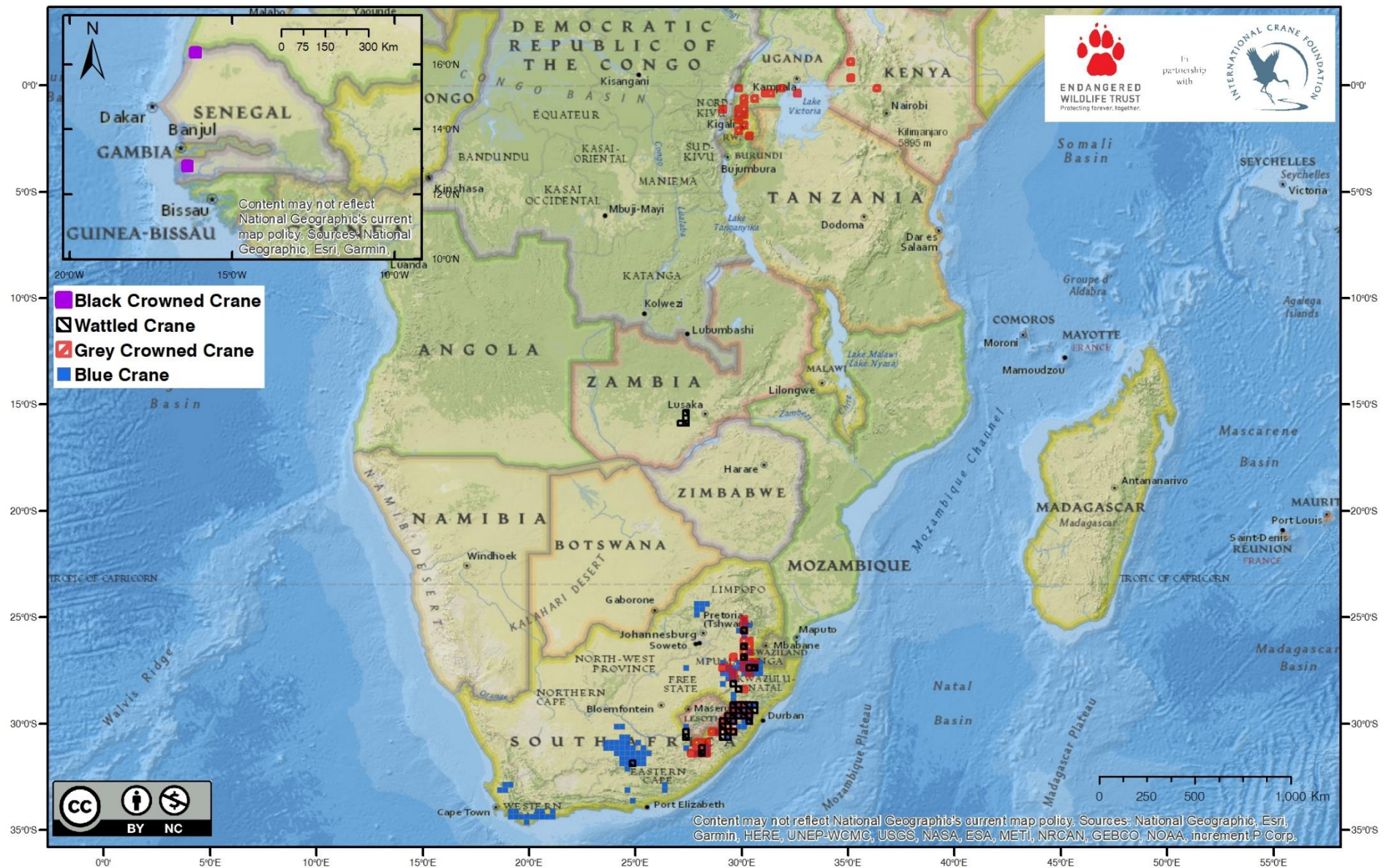


Observations of breeding in four Crane species (Family Gruidae) across Africa



The Endangered Wildlife Trust / International Crane Foundation Partnership's African Crane Conservation Programme has recorded over 2 500 crane breeding events across Africa, in collaboration with partners, from 1993 to 2018.
