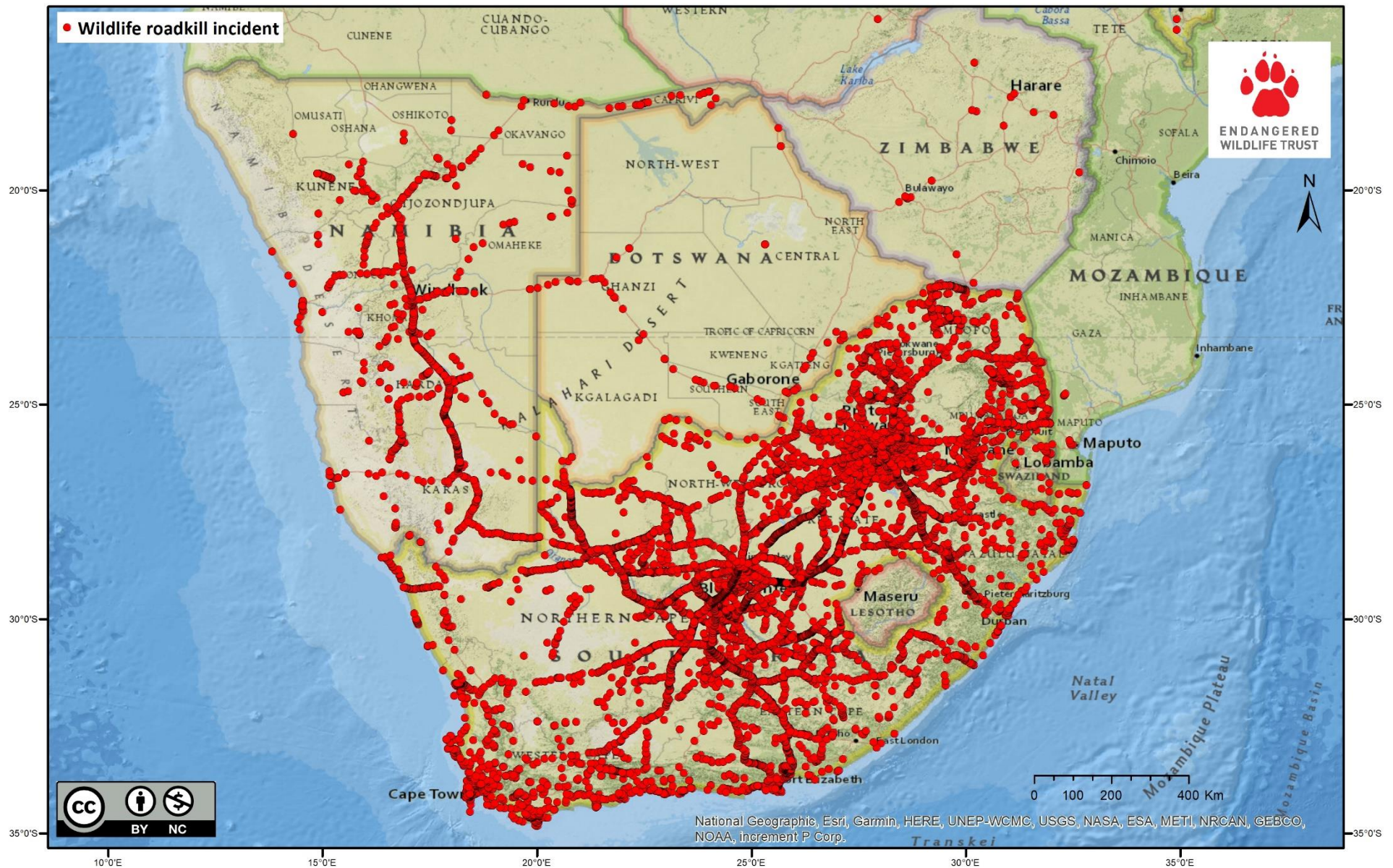


Wildlife roadkill incidents in southern Africa



The Endangered Wildlife Trust's Wildlife and Transport Programme has recorded over 20,000 wildlife road mortality incidents in southern Africa, in collaboration with numerous partners and supporters, who are dedicated to minimising the negative interactions between wildlife and transport infrastructure. These include Bakwena Platinum Corridor Concessionaire, De Beers Group of Companies, Ford Wildlife Foundation, N3 Toll Concession, Syntell Traffic Monitoring and TRAC N4. The dataset spans from 1949 to 2020, but most data were collected from 2009 onwards. Data can be requested at <http://www.ewt.org.za/biodiversitydata.html>. Please note that absence of data does not mean that there are no mortality incidents in a locality, only that no records are held in our database.
